



## **Years 1 -6 Home-School Learning**

The Home-School Learning for each week can be accessed on the Cedars Primary web page. It will have a whole school theme. On the web page you will find a tab called 'Home Learning' and once you select this you will see a web page with folders for the different year groups. When you select the year group that your child is in, you can then click on the date the work has been set. This will then take you to another web page where you will see an overview which explains the work your child can complete. Any resources you may need to access, and download will also be shown on this page. It is not necessary to print the worksheets out; you could do your workings and record your answers on a piece of paper.

**Each week's learning will be ready for your child to access from the Monday at 9am.** It will be split in to five sections:

### Maths Tasks

At Cedars Primary School we use White Rose planning and resources to teach the Maths Curriculum. We feel that it would be beneficial for the children to continue using these materials when they are doing their Home Learning. On the year group section of the web page, we will indicate the materials that your child will need to access (this will be related to the Math's class they are in and the work we feel is pitched correctly for them). When you access the White Rose Home Learning web page, you will see that for four (or sometimes five days) of the days there are video clips which explain the learning and a worksheet for the children to complete (answers are provided too). On the final day there is usually a Maths Challenge. If you feel the learning is too difficult for your child, you can always look at maths work for the year group below.

### Reading Tasks

We will suggest some activities which you can do with your child and we will set a reading comprehension for them to complete. The reading comprehension will be related to the colour on their school reading book and can be downloaded from the Home Learning and year group section of the school's web page.

Children in years 1 and 2 will sometimes have phonics related tasks to complete as well.

### Spelling Tasks

Your child's weekly spellings can be found on the Home Learning section and year group web page and they will be related to the spelling group they are in at school.

### Writing Tasks

The writing tasks will be related to the theme.

### Learning Projects

Within this section we will set some tasks related to the whole school theme. There will be a range of activities which link to other areas of the curriculum such as Music, Geography, History, Computing etc.

We really miss the children and would like to have some contact with them during this unusual time. So, each week we are going to ask the children to send us some of their work to their teacher at the following email addresses:
