



## **Nursery and Reception Home-School Learning**

Home-School Learning for each week can be accessed on the Cedars Primary web page. It will have a whole school theme. On the web page you will find a tab called 'Home Learning' and once you select this you will see a web page with folders for the different year groups. When you select the year group that your child is in, you can then click on the date the work has been set. This will then take you to another web page where you will see an overview which explains the work your child can complete. Any resources you may need to access, and download will also be shown on this page.

**Each week's learning will be ready for your child to access from the Monday at 9am.**

In **Nursery** the Home Learning overview will contain activities which are related to the seven areas of learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum.

In **Reception** the Home Learning overview will have five sections:

### Maths Tasks

At Cedars Primary School we use White Rose planning and resources to teach the Maths Curriculum. We feel that it would be beneficial for the children to continue using these materials when they are doing their Home Learning. On the year group web page, we will indicate the materials that your child will need to access. We will also suggest that you watch Number Blocks on the BBC and access NumBots.

### Reading Tasks

We will suggest some activities that you can complete with your child.

### Phonics Tasks

You can watch a Read Write Inc daily phonics lesson on You Tube (details will be given on the overview and what Speed Set Sounds your child needs to focus on). Suggestions for other phonics activities will be provided.

### Writing Tasks

The writing tasks will be related to the theme and will involve a lot of discussion between you and your child.

### Learning Projects

Within this section we will suggest that your child completes some tasks related to the whole school theme. There will be a range of activities which link to other areas in the curriculum.

We really miss the children and would like to have some contact with them during this unusual time. So, each week we are going to ask the children to send us some of their work to:
