COVID-19

Public Health England has agreed a 6-day window (Saturday 19th December - Thursday 24th December 2020) in which schools are asked to remain contactable so they can assist with contact tracing if necessary.

If your child, who attends Cedars Primary, **tests positive for COVID-19, having developed symptoms within 48 hours** (Saturday 19th December or Sunday 20th December) **of being in school please inform us immediately using the following email address:**

If your child, who attends Cedars Primary, tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), **having developed symptoms more than 48 hours** since being in school, Cedars should not be contacted.

If your child is required to self-isolate due to contact with a positive case after the first 6 days following the end of term (from 25th December 2020 - 4th January 2021), Cedars do not need to be informed about their absence until the first day of the new term (5th January 2021).
