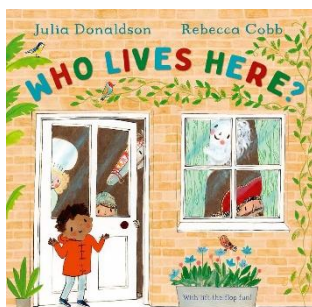


Me and My Community

Our Me and My Community topic supports the children with settling into the new rules and routines of Nursery and encourages them to make new friends and feel confident in their Cubs Class. It teaches them about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. We also explore the ways in which we are all unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them. Alongside this we will be introducing the children to traditional stories and rhymes in order to give them the opportunity to play with words and learn new vocabulary.

- Look at baby photographs and talk about how they have grown.
